IEnova Pipelines, S. de R.L. de C.V. (before Gasoductos de Chihuahua, S. de R.L. de C.V.) owns and operates the natural gas transportation system named "Gasoductos de Chihuahua". The system, located at the municipality of Ciudad Juarez, on the Chihuahua state, includes the Samalayuca Natural Gas Pipeline, a 24" diameter with an approximate length of 37 kilometers and the Gloria a Dios compressor station.

The system begins at the United States of America – Mexico Border, on the interconnection with the El Paso Natural Gas transportation system, and continues in Mexico through the towns of San Isidro and Gloria a Dios on the municipality of Juarez, Chihuahua. The system has the following interconnections:

- (1) With the "San Isidro – Samalayuca" ("SIS") pipeline, owned by Gasoducto de Aguaprieta, S. de R.L. de C.V. ("GAP").
- (2) With the "Sistema de Transporte y Almacenamiento Nacional Integrado de Gas Natural" operated by Centro Nacional de Gas Natural ("CENAGAS").
- (3) With the "Gloria a Dios – Juarez" lateral.

These interconnections allow for different natural gas supply options. Based on the guidelines by the Energy Regulatory Commission (CRE), on September 25, 2017, IEnova Pipelines started with the Open Season process for the Gasoductos de Chihuahua system, and hereby invites you to participate consulting the guidelines and schedule in its Electronic Bulletin Board:
